

## FORUM: ARE YOU BEING BRAINWASHED BY THE "AUSTRIAN SCHOOL"?

"You want to prove that Milton Friedman is a fascist? It's easy. Quote him."

This simple, elegant proof that Milton Friedman, the Chicago School guru of monetarism, is a proponent of Nazi economic policies, was offered by economist Arthur Laffer. In fact, the only regime, since that of Adolf Hitler, which has implemented a version of Friedman's economic policies, was that of Chile, under the military dictatorship of Gen Pinochet.

Even the notoriously effete extremist William F. Buckley -- who should know a fascist when he sees one -- acknowledged that there is a slight problem with Friedman: "It is possible," the snake-tongued commentator intoned, "that Milton Friedman's policies suffer from the overriding disqualification THAT THEY SIMPLY CANNOT GET A SUFFICIENT EXERCISE IN DEMOCRATIC SITUATIONS."

Recently, the senior commentator at the London "Sunday Telegraph", Sir Peregrine Worsthorne, the ever-faithful stepson of British banker Montague Norman (who as head of the powerful Bank of England, was instrumental in installing Adolf Hitler in power), called for a "form of authoritarian politics" that would allow for "cruel belt-tightening and bitter medicines to be forced down the throats of body politics."

Worsthorne, along with other such British commentators as Lord Rees-Mogg, support Newt Gingrich and Phil Gramm as leaders who can ram such policies down the throats of the American people.

The cradle for these authoritarian polices is the "Austrian School" of Friedrich von Hayek. Despite the obvious historic connection between this school and the slave labor/death camp economics of the Nazis, the "Austrian school" has achieved a new level of esteem in the U.S. today, especially among professors at major U.S. universities, think tanks such as the Heritage Foundation, and the Gramm-Gingrich wing of the Republican Party.

Proponents of this school are QUACKS, and worse -- they are promoters of FASCISM.
