*Information for authors.* The JOURNAL publishes both solicited and unsolicited manuscripts. Authors submitting manuscripts should provide four clear copies, including abstracts of not more than 250 words to assist the referees. The entire manuscript should be double-spaced. Please type on only one side of the page, using adequate margins. If possible, also provide the manuscript on disk, preferably in Word Perfect or Microsoft Word, either on IBM or Macintosh formats. Authors should enclosed a stamped, self-addressed envelope if the return of the manuscript is requested. Articles should not exceed 12,000 words. Footnotes should be used, rather than endnotes or in-text references, and must include complete bibliographical information. Footnotes should be consecutively numbered. Notes must be according to the style used in the *Chicago Manual of Style* (University of Chicago Press) or authors must resubmit them in correct form if the accepted manuscript is to be published.

The JOURNAL edits articles for clarity, brevity, and in accordance with the *Chicago Manual of Style*. After editing, authors will receive galley proofs for proofreading purposes only.

Authors should include information on their titles and professional affiliations, along with mailing address and telephone numbers. Authors should also indicate if the manuscript is to be published elsewhere or presented at a conference.
