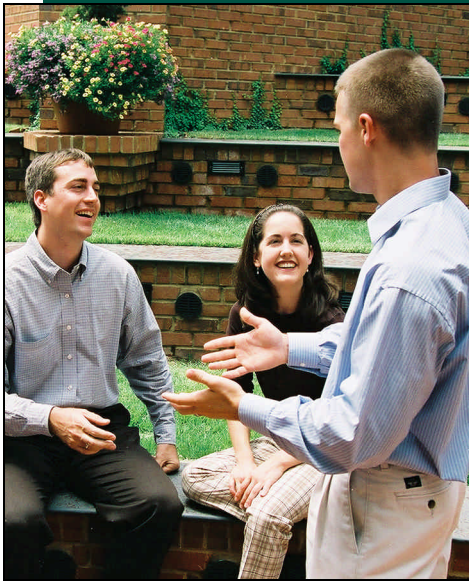


Student **SCHOLARSHIPS** **2003**
