Those who would like to have their knowledge tested at the end of the conference may choose to take part in an oral exam. A jury composed of three to five professors from our faculty will engage each examinee in a 10–15 minutes question-and-answer session based on the readings and the lectures you attend. Those who pass will receive a graded certificate. Each faculty panel will select one student as the leading candidate from its examinations. The three students will then undergo a deeper examination. The student selected by the faculty as the most learned of the conference will be awarded the Douglas E. French Scholarship Prize of \$3,000. The second and third highest scores will receive the George and Joe Eddy Prizes of \$1,000 and \$500 respectively. The winners will be announced and the prize money given at the closing cookout.
